Specific Actions for Goal #5

<u>Pray</u>: Pray for Ecological Conversion, described in Laudato Si' (216-226), "whereby the effects of (our) encounter with Jesus Christ become evident in (our) relationship with the world around (us)...(this conversion) calls for a spirit of generous care... gratitude and gratuitousness, a recognition that the world is God's loving gift, and that we are called to quietly imitate his generosity in self-sacrifice and good works..."

Act: Short Term Actions: List what you have learned about the environment and what other topics you want to learn about. Has the experience of the first four LSAP worksheets piqued your curiosity? Consider sharing Creation Care ideas with family, friends and associates... even those who may be resistant to these ideas.

Longer Term Actions: Commit to "tithing" your learning and viewing time, e.g. read or watch at least one Creation Care/environmental resource for every 10 movies, books or documentaries. Consider learning and sharing with others how to simply tell "why" something is a good or bad environmental practice.
